## The Two Paths.

The Bible however, gives us a very distinct answer on what life is about, and says there are only two paths in life:

"Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide is the gate, and broad is the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat: Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it." - Matthew 7:13-14.

There are then two ways that life can go.

The first way is that you die as you are now.

You may have tried and are convinced to be a good person, and followed your heart.

"The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked: who can know it?" - Jeremiah 17:9

But upon closing your eyes for the last time. You open them up again to your surprise, and find yourself in fire and unbelievable torment.

"And it came to pass, that the beggar died, and was carried by the angels into Abraham's bosom: the rich man also died, and was buried; And in hell he lift up his eyes, being in torments, and seeth Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom. And he cried and said, Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus, that he may dip the tip of his finger in water, and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame." - Luke 16:22-24.

You will scream, but none will hear you.

You will be begging for help, but none will be able to help you.

"So shall it be at the end of the world: the angels shall come forth, and sever the wicked from among the just, And shall cast them into the furnace of fire: there shall be wailing and gnashing of teeth." - Matthew 13:49-50.

And even after all that, you will be brought before the Throne of The Lord, standing face to face with GOD, whom you choose not to follow.

"For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ; that every one may receive the things done in his body, according to that he hath done, whether it be good or bad." - 2. Corinthians 5:10.

He will judge you of all your evil deeds you have committed in your life.

You will forever burn in it, and you will eternally regret that you didn't go the other way.

#### What is the other way then?

Can I change my sinful ways and do enough good to save myself?

"Not of works, lest any man should boast." - Ephesians 2:9.

"For I am come to set a man at variance against his father, and the daughter against her mother, and the daughter in law against her mother in law." - Matthew 10:35.
